Every student adds something special and enriches life in our residence. You can find the GHL next to a subway station on the direct line to the universities. If you choose to bike to uni you may take a ride through the park "Englischer Garten" or go the other direction to Garching. The residence is managed by a committed Residence Host who assists the students anywhere possible.

Facts: 127 single rooms, 3 double rooms, 2 rooms for special needs; all with private showers and toilets; 12 shared kitchens big hall with projector and TV, music room with a piano, billiards, table soccer, darts, bar room, garden, beverage shop, laundry room with 2 washers, dryers and ironing facility, fitness room, copy machine, bike storage in basement and shed, parking. Internet access; phone hook-up possible.

Oekumenisches Studentenwohnheim

The OEK Residence is situated in a quiet side street close to the technical university TU and can accommodate 80 students on 5 floors. It also houses the office of the ESWM association. The furnished rooms are all equipped with sinks. Almost 50 percent of the rooms have a balcony facing the residence garden.

The mix of national and international students of varying religious backgrounds provides the chance to experience different languages, cultures and traditions on a daily basis. Besides private activities you can enjoy events organized through the Tutor Program ranging from sports to culture. Our residents are encouraged to contribute to the community and take part in important decisions through the Residence Students Association, which results in a strong community sense. The committed Residence Host takes care of all residence matters and assists the students anywhere possible.

Facts: 78 single rooms (about 12 m²); common kitchens, showers and toilets; 1 room apartment with kitchenette, bathroom, toilet; music room, bar, fitness rooms, big hall with projector and screen, copy machine, bike storage in basement, billiards, table soccer and darts, laundry room with washers and dryers, garden, table tennis. internet access

Hochschulhaus Garching

The HHG is home to students, post graduates, guest lecturers, other scholars, and citizens who are not affiliated with the university. This mix of generations creates a unique setting for our residents. We believe in tolerance and open-mindedness, a strong sense of community due to our residents taking part in important decisions. Besides spontaneous private activities you can enjoy events organized through the Tutor Program or other projects ranging from sports to culture and you will get to know the other residents right away.

The residence is based close to the technical university and the Research Center Garching. The underground train and shopping facilities are also in walking distance.

The committed Residence Host assists the residents daily and a manager takes care of the building maintenance.
